INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF ARTISTS' UNION ENGLAND

We have audited the financial statements of Artists' Union England for the year ended 31 December 2014 which comprise the Income and Expenditure Account, the Balance Sheet and the related notes. Our responsibility is to audit and express an opinion on the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland). Those standards require us to comply with the Auditing Practices Board's Ethical Standards for Auditors.

Scope of the audit of the financial statements
