RESOURCES

- Our spend for 2014-15 was **£12.8 billion**
- We have an average of **over 32,000 members of staff**
- We have **350 properties** throughout the UK

LAST YEAR...



- Police recorded **3.8 million** offences in 2014
- We issued **6.5 million** passports and **2.4 million** visas
- We seized **2,853** illegal items through CITES - the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species
- We introduced the Immigration Act 2014 to increase powers to remove those who should not be here
- We introduced the Modern Slavery Act 2015 to protect those at risk of exploitation



ACHIEVEMENTS

Since 2009 we have:

- Reduced our total greenhouse gas emissions by **27%**
- Cut the number of domestic flights our staff take by **8%**
- Reduced the amount of water we use by **43%**
- Reduced the amount of paper we use by **19%**
- Reduced the amount of waste we produce by **31%**
- Increased our spend with SMEs in 2014-15 to **18%**

CARBON FOOTPRINTING

The carbon footprint of our buildings and travel is around 46,000 tonnes CO₂. In addition we estimate that we emit:

- 5,000 tonnes** from cutters
- 20,000 tonnes** from other occupied sites
- 90,000 tonnes** from Immigration Services, including accommodation and transport
- Around **1 million tonnes** from our supply chain, and
- The carbon cost of crime is estimated to be over **4 million tonnes**
