Notes/Caveats:

The figures are for Intake to the Regular Army only and therefore exclude Full Time Reserve Service, Mobilised Reserves, Army Reserve and all other Reserves.

Figures provided are for Trained and Untrained, Officer and Rank Intake into the Regular Strength.

Nationality is Nationality recorded on entry and not necessarily Nationality at birth.

Figures have been rounded; numbers ending in 5 have been rounded to the nearest multiple of 20 to prevent systematic bias.

Totals and sub-totals have been rounded separately and so may not appear to be the sum of their parts.

The data provided is for all Fijian Intake to the Regular Strength, it does not account for personnel leaving and rejoining at a later date.
