## DECC ELECTRICITY MARKET REFORM STAKEHOLDER BULLETIN

**Dear Colleagues** 

On 28 January 2015, DECC confirmed the final policy for the Non-Delivery Disincentive to the Contracts for Difference scheme. The policy is intended to encourage projects which are deliverable to enter into the CFD allocation process and to prevent speculative bidding in the allocation process. The policy will apply to applicants in the first allocation round.

Today, legislation giving effect to this policy has been laid in parliament as an <u>amendment to the Allocation Regulations</u>. A full Government Response to the consultation on Exemptions to the Non Delivery Disincentive, which closed in November 2015, has also been published today.
