Thank you for your email of 08 February requesting the following information:

*As the body responsible for the MOD Guard Service please can DIO publish any documents relating to the to the proposed new uniform for MGS staff, in particular, any provisional or confirmed uniform designs.*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that no information, in scope of your request is held.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that while it is intended that there will be a new MGS uniform in future, research is at an early stage and there are, as yet, no provisional or confirmed uniform designs.
