Thank you for your email of 21 April 2015 requesting the following information:

Under the FOI Act, could you please provide details of the number of positive drugs tests recorded by members of the armed forces in 2014. I would like these details broken down by class of drug. I would like the figures broken down by Army unit, such as regiment or corps. I would also like to know how many positive tests and which classes of drug, were also recorded by the Royal Navy and the RAF.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI Act). In regard to your request, the information is exempt under Section 21 of the FOIA, because it is reasonably accessible to you by other means. Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
