Thank you for your email of 23 November 2016 requesting the following information:

I am asking to have access to that part of the database held at RAF Wyton that describes the declassified photographs held at National Collection of Aerial Photography (NCAP) Edinburgh only of the Isle of Man 1939-1980 (approximately). Specifically, I ask for records containing the words "Isle of Man" only between 1940 and 1960.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed. The information held within scope of your request is as follows:

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that sortie 106G DY 0031 was transferred to NCAP Edinburgh prior to the transfer made in 2008.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
