

# Funding Year 2015 to 2016 Publication Field Information

### **Publication number**

Field that tracks any documents or information that the Skills Funding Agency (SFA) publishes.

#### UKPRN

The UK Register of Learning Providers (UKRLP) is a 'one-stop' portal for government departments, agencies, learners and employers to share key information about learning providers. The UKRLP allows providers to update their information in one place and share this across agencies such as the SFA, the Higher Education Funding Council for England and UCAS.

We use the UK Provider Register Number (UKPRN), which is verified by UKRLP as part of our due diligence processes ahead of contracting with a provider.

Each learning provider has a unique UKPRN, which they must use to submit data to us through the Individualised Learner Record.

## Provider name

The provider name is the name of the legal entity with whom we will enter into a contract. The provider name is verified by us using Companies House, UKRLP and audited accounts information provided by the provider.

### **LEP Area**

The Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP) area is based on the postcode of the provider's main correspondence address as supplied to us and verified with UKRLP. Providers whose main correspondence address is outside England have not been allocated a LEP area.

## **Funding line**

For the 2015 to 2016 funding year the Adult Skills Budget is made up of adult apprenticeship funding and non-apprenticeship funding.

In 2015 to 2016, Community Learning includes a range of community-based and outreach learning opportunities, primarily managed and delivered by local authorities and general further education colleges.

In 2015 to 2016, 16 to 18 Apprenticeships are funded by the Education Funding Agency and managed by us. This includes managing the funding for 16 to 18 Traineeships for providers that do not have a contract with the Education Funding Agency. 16 to 18 Apprenticeships (including SFA-funded 16 to 18 Traineeships) is shown separately to Adult Skills and Community Learning.

Discretionary Learner Support (DLS) can be used to help disadvantaged students with the costs associated with further education which may include course fees, childcare, transport costs, trips and other equipment. DLS is funded and reported separately to Adult Skills.

24+ Advanced Learning Loans Facility and Bursary 2015 to 2016 value shows the amount of funding that has been allocated for 24+ Advanced Learning Loans Facility and Bursary and is funded and reported separately to Adult Skills.

Education and training provided by the Offender Learning and Skills Service (OLASS) is procured, funded and reported against separately to Adult Skills.

The contract value for the AGE facility includes the 16 to 18 and 19 to 24 AGE facility and is for the 2015 to 2016 financial year.

European Social Fund (ESF) values are proxy allocations for the 2015 to 2016 funding year. These will be included when new ESF contracts are awarded.



# Value type

The value of activity earned by providers is worked out by us using the verified Individualised Learner Record data they have submitted to us. We compare those earnings to providers' contract values and apply our published performance management rules during the year to work out the value of activity that we will fund.

We will update the 2015 to 2016 funding year values file, through the 2015 to 2016 funding year and it will detail:

- funding statement value
- performance-management point 1
- performance-management point 2

## Value

The values published are shown in pounds (£).

Owing to contract system rounding, the published values may be different to those issued on provider and employer contracts.
