### **Request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the “FOI Act”)**

I refer to your email of 17 November 2016 in which you requested information under the FOI Act from NHS Improvement. Since 1 April 2016, Monitor and the NHS Trust Development Authority (TDA) are operating as an integrated organisation known as NHS Improvement. For the purposes of this decision, NHS Improvement means Monitor and the TDA.

### **Your request**

You made the following request:

*I would like to know how many Private beds there are in NHS facilities compared to past years.*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 50 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 40 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 30 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 20 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 10 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 5 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities 2 years ago?*

*How many private beds and how many free beds were there in NHS facilities last year?*

*By NHS facilities I mean any building giving treatment by the NHS.*

### **Decision**

NHS Improvement does not hold the information that you have requested. You may wish to contact NHS England who may hold this information.

### **Review rights**

If you consider that your request for information has not been properly handled or if you are otherwise dissatisfied with the outcome of your request, you can try to resolve this informally with the person who dealt with your request. If you remain dissatisfied, you may seek an internal review within NHS Improvement of the issue or the decision. A senior member of NHS Improvement's staff, who has not previously been involved with your request, will undertake that review.

If you are dissatisfied with the outcome of any internal review, you may complain to the Information Commissioner for a decision on whether your request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the FOI Act.
