## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: MENTAL HEALTH**

I refer to your email dated 9 November 2015 which was acknowledged on 10 November 2015.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

**“Under the Freedom of Information Act, please provide copies of the following records for each of the years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and (up to the receipt of this email) in 2015:**

- **The total number of requests for police attendance at an incident**
- **The total number of requests for police attendance at an incident which was identified from the very start as being mental health related and which was given an opening incident type of 'Mental health'**
- **The total number of requests for police attendance at an incident which was given an opening incident type that was not 'Mental Health' but which then attracted an incident qualifier 'Mental Health' as a consequence of information becoming available during the investigation.”**

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
