STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN IMMIGRATION RULES

The Home Secretary has, with effect from 27 October 1995, made the change hereinafter stated in the rules laid down by him as to the practice to be followed in the administration of the Immigration Act 1971 for regulating entry into and the stay of persons in the United Kingdom and contained in the statement laid before Parliament on 23 May 1994 (HC 395), as amended. The amending statement was laid before Parliament on 20 September 1994 (Cm 2663).

1. In the Appendix to HC 395 after "Gabon" there shall be inserted "Gambia".
2. Paragraph 60(i) of HC 395 of 1994 shall not apply to any application for an extension of stay for the purpose of studying made by a national of Gambia whose current leave to enter or remain was granted before 27 October 1995.
