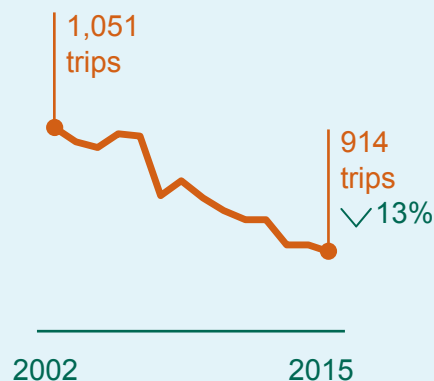




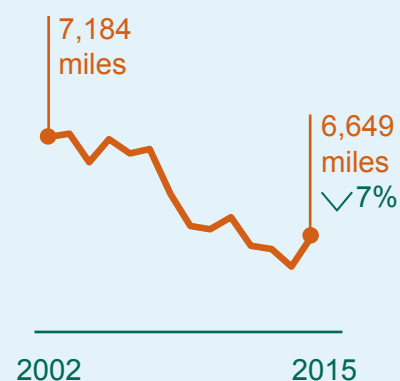

Average trips per person per year



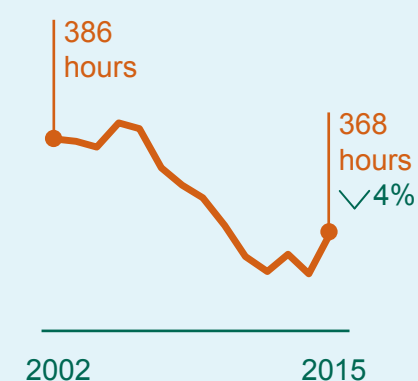
Distance [NTS0101]

Average time travelled per year

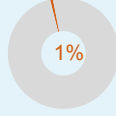
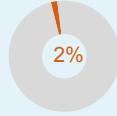
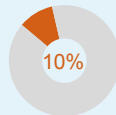
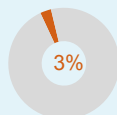
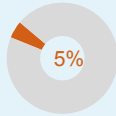
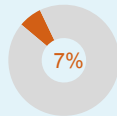
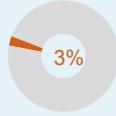
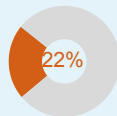
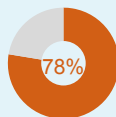
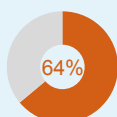

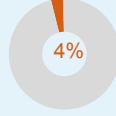
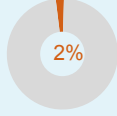

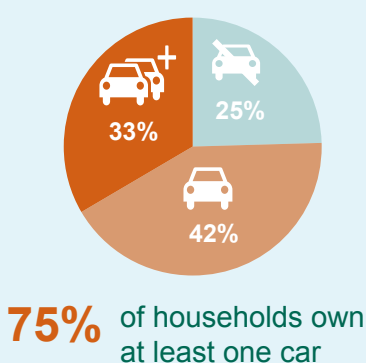
Gender [NTS0601, 0605]

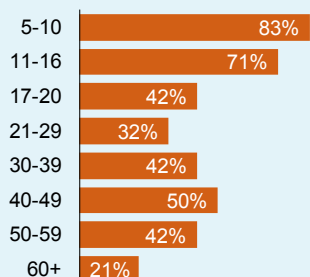

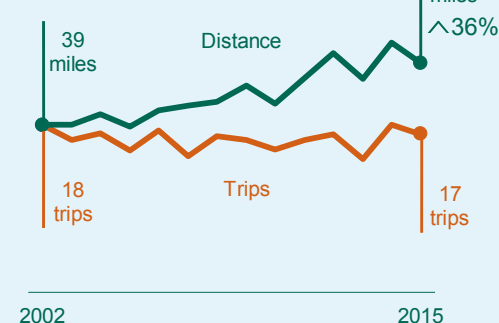
