## **AUTHORIZED AMENDMENT**

The MAA, in consultation with external stakeholders, conducted a review of regulation pertinent to Airborne Forces (AF) and their associated Airborne Equipment (AE). Whilst AE is not classified as an Air System by the MAA, it has been treated as such by AOC 2Gp who has performed an Operating Duty Holder (ODH) equivalent role, by Defence Equipment and Support (DE&S) who have assured the airworthiness of AE and by other stakeholders in the AF community. This Regulatory Article (RA) provides a framework to ensure this practice continues. RA 1150 identifies those RAs from the GEN 1000 series that are applicable to AE and AF; and provides guidance on AE and AF duty of care along with Aviation Duty Holder responsibilities. The applicability of FLY 2000, CAW 4000 and DME 5000 Regulation is the subject of further work and will be addressed in future work strands as resources permit.

Notes: The Regulated Community have until 31 Mar 17 to comply with the requirements of RA 1205 - Air System Safety Cases.

MAA/RN/2015/06 (D Tech) - Airborne Equipment and Airborne Forces (AF) regulation, will be withdrawn.
