Your email dated 21<sup>st</sup> May 2015, which clarified your earlier email dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 2015, is considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You requested the following information:

*I am looking for some information of contract wins over the last 4 years in relation to Fire Detection and the companies to whom they were awarded.*

*I am interested in the product costs associated with a recent Fire detection (Flame) project at RAF Lossiemouth, within the last 2 years. Further to this any other large projects over £100k of product would be of interest, limited at say 20 to ensure we are under the £600 limit.*

I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) holds some information relevant to your request. I regret, however, that a search of our records has failed to identify a contract for a Fire detection (Flame) project at RAF Lossiemouth. Should you wish to pursue this matter then further information will be required to conduct another search.

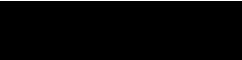
I can advise that a search of the MOD e-Procurement database has identified four fire-detection contracts awarded during the last four financial years which are valued in excess of £100,000. Details for each contract is given in the table at the Annex to this letter.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail [CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk](mailto:CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk)). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
