Thank you for your email of 9 November 2016 requesting the following information:

"Do you have a list of type certifications your institution has issued?"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below:

I am interpreting your question as relating to aircraft Military Type Certification. On 21 April 2016, the MAA issued the first UK Military Type Certificate (MTC) for the Rotary Wing Command Support Air Transport (RWCSAT) AW109SP air system. To date no other MTCs have been issued.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that an article is available in the August edition of the MAA Flyer regarding the presentation of the first MTC. This can be found at www.gov.uk/MAA.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
