We will Rise cop Tuesday 10 November
Returning Monday 16 November

We will Rise cop Thur 17 December and
Return Tuesday 5 January 2016

Rise cop Thurs 11 February, returning
Return Mon 22 February

The proposed dates for sitting Fridays in the coming session are; 11
September, 16 October, 23 October, 30 October, 6 November, 20
November, 4 December, 22 January 2016, 29 January, 5 February, 26
February, 4 March and 11 March.

It may also help colleagues to know that I intend to bring to the
House the motion allocating the Chairs of Select Committees to
parties next week, in order to allow the process for the election of
Chairs to proceed. I intend the debate to take place next Wednesday.
