#### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Purpose

This FE Choices Employer Satisfaction open data guidance describes the formatting and content of the Open Data files for Employer Satisfaction.

#### 2. File Contents

#### 2.1 Files Published

- **Provider File** Displays summary information for the provider, such as the providers overall score and comparison scores. Where data isn't available, the file also contains the missing score reason
- **Response File** Displays the number of eligible employers and survey response information for each age range and survey type
- Skills Area File Displays information about the extra two voluntary questions employers can answer in relation to the particular subjects their employees studied
