Thank you for your email dated 6 March 2015 requesting information on Milford Hospital. For ease of reference your request is below:

"I would like to receive an up to date project directory and a list of sub-contractors, suppliers and consultants of all of the companies involved in the 108 Residential Units. Scheme comprises approval of reserved matters (appearance, landscaping, layout and scale) following the outline approval of WA/2012/1592 for demolition of buildings and redevelopment of land adjoining Milford Hospital, Tuesley Lane to provide 104 two, three, four & five bedrooms new (Class C3) residential units, works to 12 residential units (The Crescent), works to Allison House and staff cottages to provide 4 (Class C3) residential units, including 36 affordable homes access and diversion of Public Footpath 161, Busbridge. The associated works include sewer systems, landscaping, infrastructure, enabling works, cable laying and access roads."

Information not held

The HCA does not appoint the subcontractors, suppliers or consultants for this scheme. As such, we are unable to provide you with the information you have requested. In the case of HCA-owned land, the appointment of subcontractors, suppliers and consultants is undertaken by the developer responsible for the delivery of the site. Where the HCA has provided funding for the delivery of affordable housing, such appointments will be made by the Registered Provider in receipt of the funding.
