

RA 4265 – Maintenance Philosophy – General

Rationale

▶ RA 4265 relating to Laser Equipment Maintenance has been withdrawn as the content does not require regulating as Continuing Airworthiness activity. Duty Holders are already required by DSA 01.1¹, JSP 375² and JSP 390³ to implement measures to ensure the safety of personnel within their areas of responsibility, and that is the more appropriate mechanism for regulating the subject activity. To complement the withdrawal of this regulation, appropriate changes will be made to the more detailed guidance in the MAP-01⁴ in due course. ◀
