P2G PT Mandated Extent of Work Recording for Gazelle Aircraft

- 1. Gazelle aircraft are subject to reduced work recording. All instances of the following activities are to be recorded using the Work Type Codes listed at MOD Form 799/5A(IS):
 - a. All scheduled maintenance, including SI(T) compliance and Modification embodiment.
 - b. All fault rectification.
 - c. All husbandary rectification.
 - d. All preparatory and actual aircraft inspection work for Zonal Phase Maintenance inspection.
 - e. All preparation and recovery work for transportation.
 - f. All instances of Cannibalization to service another aircraft, spares pool or Deployment Spares Pack.

Notes:

- 1. System and sub-system codes are to be populated in GOLDesp on all fault rectification Electronic Maintenance Work Orders (EMWO).
- 2. Work Identification Number (WIN) is a 7 digit code, derived from the system, sub-system chapters of the Aircraft Maintenance Manual, Topic
- 1, 2 digits for the system, 2 digits for the sub-system and the remaining digits as '0's. Codes are not required on the MOD Form 707B(IS) when GOLDesp is "off line". During Catch Up after a period of "off-line" operations, the system and sub-system codes are to be populated on GOLDesp to enable interrogation of faults by system.

WIN Example:

Main Rotor Blade Removal/Installation - Chapter 50, Sub-Chapter 20 = WIN 5020000

3. When How Found (WHF) codes. When a fault is identified during scheduled maintenance activity and a Work Type 05 (unscheduled) EMWO is raised; the Activity Code from the open Work Type 01 (scheduled) EMWO is to be entered as the WHF code of the Work Type 05 EMWO.
