The predecessor school, Hextable School, was previously judged inadequate but had improved to RI (with some good areas) by May 2013 before it became an Academy. The Academy specialises in performing arts (including music) therefore it will aim to attract a particular cohort of students interested in arts, so the UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the school.
St Columba's Catholic Boys' School	Academy Converters	900 Existing surplus:12.8%	55%	Good	<b>Moderate</b> - This is a single sex faith school which aims to attract a particular cohort of students in line with their faith ethos so the impact of the UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the school.
Orchards Academy	Academy Converters	747 Existing surplus:33.1%	55%	Good	<b>Moderate</b> – The Academy opened in September 2010 sponsored by The Kemnal Academies Trust. The Academy's was judged 'Good' in their first Ofsted inspection (Feb 2012), an improvement from their prior performance.. Although the school has a large surplus we believe the school will be able to reduce this because of their Ofsted judgement, which shows the school has improved since being an Academy. The UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the school.

North West Kent College of Technology	3649	75.4%	526.7	Satisfactory	<b>Moderate</b> – The College was initially a sponsor of the UTC proposal but has now withdrawn from the project. The college is the closest to the proposed UTC and offer’s similar curriculum at KS5 and KS4. As the college is a large provider of post 16 educations offering a diverse range of pathways and short courses for post-16 learners and adults of all abilities, drawing from a wide catchment, losing a few students will not have much of an impact on the college’s long term viability. In addition, we believe the college is likely to increase the number of 14-16 year olds it takes with the introduction of the Wolf-implementation on direct funding. Therefore the UTC is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the college.
