Your correspondence dated 8 February 2016 has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). You requested the following information:

*Please disclose the amount reimbursed to the MOD by the Libyan Government in relation to the £13.9 million costs for training Libyan troops at Basingbourn Barracks.*

*Please disclose the amount of each payment and when they were made;*

*Please provide a breakdown of the £13.9 million cost, including a detailed breakdown of the repairs bill.*

I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) holds this information. The information is exempt under Section 21 of the FOIA, because it is reasonably accessible to you by other means. It was provided to you in response to your previous requests for this information under reference numbers FOI2015/01776 which answered the first 2 questions and the first part of the 3rd question and FOI2015/04144 which answered the second part of the 3rd question.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that
