

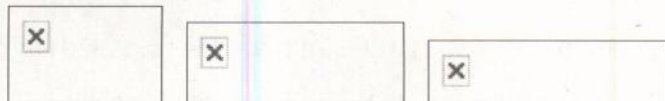

These links tell you a bit more

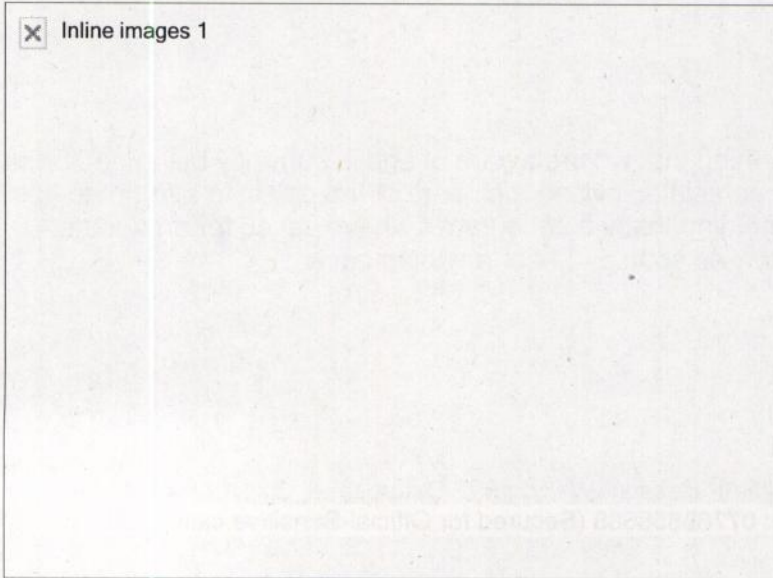

The game is about teamwork, coordination, you get to see and visit interesting places. Makes you walk and exercise

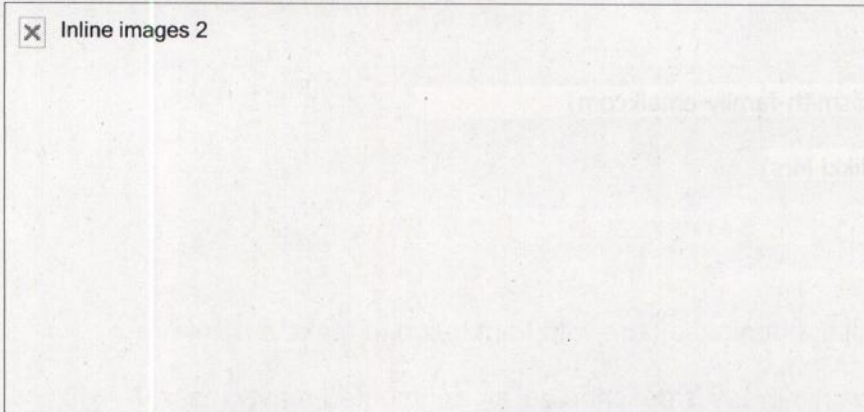
So why am I writing to you ?
