Thank you for your email of 01 December 2015 requesting the following information:

"Under the FOI act could you supply details of the department's electricity bill for the year 2014/15"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below:

The total MOD-wide spend on electricity in 2014/15 was £226,913,431.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that the above figure refers to the total spend on electricity across the entire MOD estate worldwide. The MOD has intervened by investing in energy efficient technology, which has lessened the effect of rising energy prices. Alongside technological intervention we promote responsible utility consumption across the estate.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact DIO Secretariat in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
