We refer to your email of 11 December 2016, which requested the following information:-

"Could you please provide information on;

- 1. The number of rounds that have been fired by British Forces in each Brigade rotation in Helmand province from Herrick 4 up until and including Herrick 20. If possible could this include Anti-Armour and Artillery rounds as well
- 2. The amount of ammunition expended by WAH-64 Apache's deployed in Afghanistan from Herrick 4 up until and including Herrick 20"

Your correspondence has been treated as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and we can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. The information you have requested can be found at Annex A.

The majority of forces were based in Helmand Province, but there was also a presence in other areas such as Kabul and Kandahar. Data was collated on the overall amount of ammunition expended by British Forces across Afghanistan, but not in Helmand Province specifically.

It was therefore not possible to provide information on the amount of ammunition expended in Helmand province alone, and we have instead provided information on the amount of ammunition expended by British Forces across Afghanistan for each Brigade rotation.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact this office in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
