## Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The Division holds some of the information that you have requested.

The Division does not hold any information concerning the assets and liabilities of the estate. Any information held by the Division in this respect was passed to the claimant and copies were not retained.

I can confirm that the Division has not received a contribution to our costs and disbursements.

The Division holds information relating to the address of the deceased. This information can be found on the death certificate of the deceased. The deceased died in Constable, Norfolk. Certificates can be obtained from the local Registrar where the event took place or from the General Registrar Office (GRO), PO Box 2, Southport, Merseyside, PR8 2JD or by telephoning 0845 603 7788. The information is reasonably accessible to you by other means and is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 21 of the Act. This exemption confers absolute exemption from the requirement to provide information pursuant to section 1(1)(b) of the Act.
