

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Slough Borough Council Bridleway 93 Modification Order 2015 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following modifications:

- Delete all of the references in the Order to "*bridleway*" and insert "*byway open to all traffic*".
- Replace the notation on the Order Map for a bridleway with the notation for a byway open to all traffic and amend the map key accordingly.
- Replace the existing widths of the relevant sections of the route shown on the Order Map with a width of 9 metres.
