New burdens payment for Real Time Information bulk data matching initiative

Background

- From 6 October 2014 the Real Time Information (RTI) bulk data matching initiative began issuing referrals to local authorities (LAs) across England, Scotland and Wales. As described in <u>Circular HB A15/2014</u> this is the first in a series of tranches during which LAs will be issued around 223,000 RTI referrals for administration.
- In response to LA concerns, we agreed a package to support LAs processing the RTI referrals. The package includes the provision of IT solutions already in place and the payment of new burdens funding to compensate LAs for the burden associated with processing each referral and any debt recovery action.

Agreed Funding

- 3. Details of the new burdens funding were provided to LAs in the 'New Burdens Letter' issued to LA Chief Executives on 4 July 2014. However since this letter was issued we have consulted with members of the Local Authority Associations (LAAS) Steering Group and the Practitioners Operational Group to identify the most appropriate method for distributing the new burdens funding to LAs.
- 4. Following these discussions, agreement has been reached with the LAAs to pay the new burdens funding based on the administration subsidy that LAs are receiving during this financial year.
- 5. The LAAS agreed that funding should be paid in two blocks. The first payment will be based on an estimate of 50% of the total referrals each LA is expected to receive during 2014/15. This will then be followed with payment of the further 50%, which will reflect the actual number of RTI referrals received by each LA.
- 6. LAs can expect the first of the two new burdens payments to be paid 28 November 2014; with the final payment being made before the end of the financial year, upon completion of the exercise.
- 7. LAs are reminded that the figures used to calculate the new burden were £10.13 towards the administrative burden of carrying out this work and a further £5.00 towards any associated debt recovery action.
- 8. Annex A provides details of the amount each LA will be paid for the first payment. A further subsidy circular will be produced before the end of the financial year to inform LAs of how much the second payment will be and when this will be paid.
