

## Maiden Erlegh Secondary Free School, Reading -Impact Assessment

The table below details the potential impact on the 8 secondary schools within a 2.6 mile radius (based on the distance travelled by 80% of pupils of secondary school age travel to school in Reading). The surplus figures cover all secondary year groups unless indicated.
