Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Orders have been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Orders.

The **start date** for the above Orders is **19 April 2016**.

Consideration of the Orders will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Orders, if confirmed without modifications, will be to Modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area **by i)** upgrading Bridleway no. 3405 (Monument Lane/Park Lane) to restricted byway status, commencing at the junction of Monument Lane and the B.2147 at grid reference 7818 0935 (point A), via grid references 7742 0964 (point B), 7707 0969 (point C), 7672 0986 (point D), 7605 0969 (point F), 7569 0948 (point G) to the Stanstead Park Road at grid reference 7569 0937 (point H) **and ii)** adding a byway open to all traffic from Brooks Nap Road, at grid reference 7712 1073 (point X) through Park Slip, to joint Monument Lane/Park Lane (Path no. 3405) at grid reference 7707 0969 (point Y), in the parish of Stoughton, as shown on the Order maps.

Any person wishing to view the statements of case and other documents relating to this Order may do so by appointment at the offices of the Directorate of Law, Assurance & Strategy, West Sussex County Council, County Hall, West Street, Chichester, West Sussex PO19 1RQ during normal office hours (call 0330 2222705, 0330 2225389 or 0330 2222687 to make an appointment).

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 03 May 2016]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 14 June 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 26 July 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

We cannot accept any libellous, racist or abusive comments. Any documents containing such comments will be returned.

This Order is made by the County Council of West Sussex under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the Act') because it appears to that authority that the Chichester Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii), namely, that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The West Sussex County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 20th November 2007
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for Chichester shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on plan no.01409 attached to the Order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The West Sussex County Council (Chichester - No.1 (Stoughton: Path no. 3405)) Definitive Map Modification Order 2008.

SCHEDULE

PART I

Modification of the Chichester Definitive Map

Description of public right of way to be upgraded

Bridleway no.3405, known as Monument Lane and Park Lane, in the parish of Stoughton, for its full historic width as shown on the 1874 edition Ordnance Survey map, commencing at grid reference 7818 0935, (point A on the order plan), the junction of Monument Lane and the B.2147, having a 2.5 metre wide compacted chalk surface and running generally north-westwards, passing 'Bayleys', the covered Reservoir, Racton Tower and the access road to New Barn Cottage, (grid reference 7742 0964, point B), then, having a 2.5 metre wide natural surface of compacted chalk, small stones and earth, continuing westwards to its junction with Park Lane and Park Slip (grid reference 7707 0969, point C), then on the same natural compacted surface continuing north-westwards to grid reference 7672 0986 (point D), then turning west-south-westwards passing 'Pheasant Court' at the crossroads formed by footpaths nos.

503/1 and 2998 (point E), then south-westwards to footpath no. 532 (grid reference 7605 0969, point F) then on a natural earth path to footpath no. 531 (grid reference 7569 0948, point G) and then turning southwards to the Stansted Park Road (grid reference 7569 0937, point H), a total distance of 2844 metres as shown by the broken line and small arrowheads on plan no. 01409.

Restricted Byway	Monument Lane and Park Lane, in the parish of Stoughton, for its full historic width as shown on the 1874 edition Ordnance Survey map, commencing at (grid reference 7818 0935), the junction of Monument Lane and the B.2147, having a 2.5 metre wide compacted chalk surface and running generally north-westwards, passing 'Bayleys', the covered Reservoir, Racton Tower and the access road to New Barn Cottage, (grid reference 7742 0964), then, having a 2.5 metre wide natural surface of compacted chalk, small stones and earth, continuing westwards to its junction with Park Lane and Park Slip (grid reference 7707 0969), then on the same natural compacted surface continuing north-westwards to grid reference 7672 0986 then turning west-south-westwards passing 'Pheasant Court' at the crossroads formed by footpaths nos. 503/1 and 2998, then south-westwards to footpath no. 532 (grid reference 7605 0969) then on a natural earth path to footpath no. 531 (grid reference 7569 0948) and then turning southwards to the Stansted Park Road (grid reference 7569 0937), a total distance of 2844 metres.

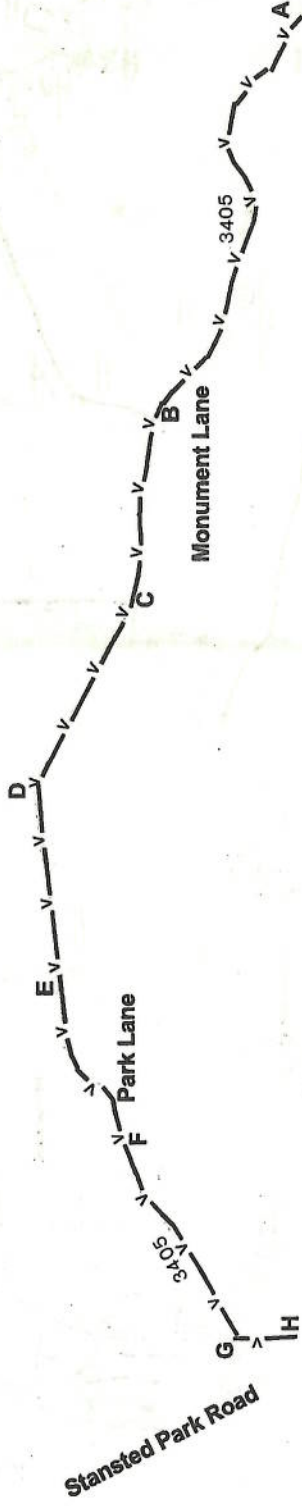
