REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITORS TO THE MEMBERS OF THE BRITISH LACE FEDERATION

We have audited the financial statements of The British Lace Federation for the year ended 30 April 2015 on pages five to seven. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is applicable law and the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008) (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice applicable to Smaller Entities).
