



Satellite-tracking device registration (VMS 2)

1. Under Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 404/2011, UK fishing vessels 12 metres and over in overall length are required to carry on board a working satellite terminal for monitoring purposes.
2. This form is to be used for the registration (as well as re-registering vessels following change of ownership, tracking device) of UK fishing vessels onto the UK fisheries departments' (UKFD) vessel monitoring system. It must be completed by the vessel owner or representative and sent to the appropriate fisheries monitoring centre (see contact details at Annex A).
3. **All** parts of this form must be signed and completed. Failure to complete all sections may result in the form being rejected and returned.
4. Completing this form does not imply UKFDs' acceptance of this terminal in complying with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 404/2011. UKFDs reserve the right to test this unit before acceptance.
