# New Burdens payment for the Real Time Information bulk data matching initiative

#### **Background**

- The Real Time Information (RTI) bulk data matching initiative was originally intended to be a one-off exercise that would only run during 2014/15. However, owing to the success of the project, provisions are in place to allow the initiative to continue and a further two tranches have already been delivered to local authorities (LAs) during May and June. Bulletin HB G5/2015 refers.
- 2. The project has consulted with LA representatives attending the Practitioners' Operational Group and the LAA Steering Group to agree the provisions detailed in this circular.
- 3. Agreement has been reached for the RTI bulk data matching to continue until a strategic solution for the use of RTI data across legacy benefits, including Housing Benefit (HB), is implemented.
- 4. Timescales for the wider use of RTI are still being developed but the current assumption is that RTI bulk data matching will continue for the whole of 2015/16.

## **Agreed funding**

- 5. Details of the proposal for New Burdens funding was provided to LAs in the 'New Burdens Letter' issued to LA Chief Executives and HB Managers on 8 May 2015, and in the aforementioned bulletin HB G5/2015 published 15 May 2015.
- 6. As reported by <u>circular HB S11/2014</u> LA representatives previously agreed that funding should be paid in two blocks. The first payment made to LAs in November 2014 reflected 50% of the expected referrals, and was based upon the subsidy caseload figures for each LA. The second payment, made in March 2015, then reflected the actual number of RTI referrals received by each LA for the whole period, and offset the initial payment made. LA representatives have agreed that this payment model should be repeated for 2015/16.
- 7. LAs are reminded that the New Burdens funding paid in support of the initiative will be £10.23 (an increase from £10.13 in 2014/15) towards the administration of each referral, plus an additional £5.00 towards the cost of any associated debt recovery.
- 8. Annex A provides details of the amount each LA should expect to receive week commencing 29 June 2015.
