REQUEST FOR INFORMATION: VARIOUS FRAMEWORKS / CONTRACTS – START AND END DATES

Thank you for your request for information, which we received on Monday 12 January 2015, about the start and end dates, including values of the following frameworks / contracts:

- 21119 - Procurement of services for WasteDataFlow Administration and Management. *(255201-2014; United Kingdom-London: Refuse and waste related services)*
- 20162 - The provision of a fully managed service for the delivery of tuberculin Testing, supply of other veterinary services including Incident response to government in England and Wales. *(238866-2014; United Kingdom-London: Veterinary services)*
- 21329 - Services of a Veterinary nature to government across England, NI, Scotland & Wales. *(185208-2014; United Kingdom-London: Veterinary services)*
- 20350 - Procurement of Joint Venture partner for the Secretary of State for DEFRA; delivery of scientific and research services currently delivered by DEFRA, (including the Food and Environment Research Agency) and other Crown Bodies. *(154013-2014; United Kingdom-London: Research and development services and related consultancy services)*

As you know, we have handled your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

21119 - Procurement of services for WasteDataFlow Administration and Management: this contract started on 7 January 2015 and ends on 6 January 2018, with an option to extend for a further two years. The value of the contract is £1,494,526.25.

21329 - Services of a Veterinary nature to government across England, NI, Scotland & Wales: this framework agreement has been published on Contracts Finder and confirms that the contract started on 1 October 2014 and ends on 30 September 2018. As this is a Framework, there is no guaranteed spend; however the estimated amount of spend over the term of the agreement is £2m.



The other two contracts have yet to be awarded, and therefore this information is not held by Defra. They will be published on Contracts Finder once they have been awarded.
