Thank you for your email of 5 October 2016 asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

I would like to request a copy of the 2010 Memorandum of Understanding between the UK and Kenya.

You subsequently clarified your question with:

The 2010 Memorandum of Understanding between the UK and Kenya I am referring to is that to which the "Statement of Understanding Between the UK and Goverment of Kenya on the Defence Co-operation Agreement" (29/09/15) refers to in paragraph 2, which states:

We hope and expect that our respective Parliaments will agree to ratify the Defence Cooperation Agreement according to the proper procedures in both our countries. Pending ratification, **we furthermore agree to extend the 2010 Memorandum of Understanding** for a further 6 (six) months from 21st October 2015, or until entry into force of the Defence Cooperation Agreement, whichever comes earlier.

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed the search for the information which you requested. I can confirm that the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) does hold information relevant to your request and are releasing all relevant information to you, without exemption.
