## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your e-mail Freedom of Information request regarding a breakdown of Strategic Road Network Investment on the 10 February 2014.

You requested the following information:

➤ a breakdown by year, segment (as per Highways Agency Annual Report categories), resource, capital, income and expenditure (example of format enclosed), of the £24.0bn announced investment within the 'Transforming England's Strategic Road Network' published on 10 February 2014 (enclosed);

The £24.0bn figure was a rounded aggregate of grouped areas of spend as published in the leaflet, 'Transforming England's Strategic Road Network'.

Investment – £24br (maintenance and enhancement) in this and dext Partlament

The period covered in this statement is the 5 years, of the current Parliament, 2010/11 to 2014/15 and the following six years 2015/16 up to 2020/21.

The split of this in this Parliament as per the rounded totals in the leaflet is as follows:-

The £6.6bn in this Parliament was rounded to £7bn and the £16.8bn for the six years from 15/16 was rounded to £17bn to total the £24bn in the leaflet.

Note that the leaflet did not include resource maintenance in the period for this Parliament (10/11 to 14/15).

➤ a reconciliation between the £24.0bn announced investment in 'Transforming England's Strategic Road Network' published on 10 February 2014 (enclosed), and the 'total expenditure on capital improvements and maintaining the network (resource and capital)' of £21.4bn as per Freedom of Information Request ref: 712,722 (enclosed).

The £21.4bn you have quoted (from FOI 712,722) covers 5 years of existing Parliament plus the 5 year RIS 1 period from 2015/16 to 2019/20. This is not comparable with the totals in the leaflet which include an additional year (2020/21). Also in order to compare with the leaflet, resource maintenance for the current Parliament would need to be removed so that the totals quoted are on a consistent basis.

Please find a table attached in the format requested in the Highways Agency groupings as per Annual Report & Accounts.

The source of the figures for the years 2010/11 to 2013/14 is from published and audited Annual Reports and Accounts. 2014/15 is as per the published Business Plan. This is the breakdown in the format that you requested showing the totals reported in FOI 712,722.







From 2015/16 onwards the Highways Agency will no longer exist and will progress forwards as Highways England. The figures shown for 2015/16 to 2020/21 as published in the Road Investment Strategy.
