

NATIONAL ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMMES - progression and further details (current as at May 2015).

Progress is about the young person's capability rather than eligibility. When ready, a YP should progress to the next level rather than progress sideways with more engagement, according to their needs. (Some may require more engagement whereas others may be ready for L1 or L2 programmes of study or Traineeships after just a bit of engagement).
