Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

You asked for the following information from the Treasury Solicitor's Department ("the Department"):

We are writing to inquire if you have any information from your files regarding the following estate:

Davi COHEN, who died 11th December 2011.

The information released by the Treasury Solicitor says that Davi was born on 25th October 1935, in "Israel". Can you tell me any further information regarding where specifically in Israel this occurred?

Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I have interpreted your request to mean that you require any information that we hold about the deceased's origins and/or extended family that will help you find entitled kin.

The Division holds some of the information that you have requested.

Information held by the Division concerning the deceased's origins, family and her place of birth has been published on the Division's website. You can find the information here:

The information is reasonably accessible to you by other means and is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 21 of the Act. This exemption confers absolute exemption from the requirement to provide information pursuant to section 1(1)(b) of the Act.
