Thank you for your letter of 15<sup>th</sup> January 2015 requesting the following information:

*Vehicle: Land Rover Defender 'Wolf' 110, military registration KN35AA*

*I currently own and operate the ex-military Land Rover detailed above and I am trying to locate details relating to the maintenance and safe operation of this vehicle. I am aware that numerous modifications have been carried out to the Land Rover Defender TUL(HS) / TUM(HS) since its introduction, many of which are of a safety nature.*

*I refer to the Modification Instructions contained with AESP 2320-D-128-811 and more specifically to Modification Instruction 24 onwards. I have previously obtained copies of Instructions 1 to 23 inclusive.*

*Any information would be gratefully received and would be for personal use as described and not for onward circulation in any form. Paper or electronic copies of any available information would be equally acceptable.*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal
