Who we are

Ofsted is best known for inspecting places where young people go to school or college to make sure they are getting the best possible education. You might have met an Ofsted inspector at your school or college.

We don't just inspect schools and colleges. Ofsted is now working with the Care Quality Commission to find out how well young people's special educational needs are being met in the area where they live. We call this a local area.

The Care Quality Commission is like Ofsted but looks at health services, like hospitals, rather than schools and colleges. It is usually called the CQC.

What this is all about

The government has brought in a new law to make sure special educational needs are being met. It has asked Ofsted and CQC to find out how well the new law is working and to say what more needs to be done. Our inspectors will visit local areas to do this and we think they should look at:

- how good the area is at finding out what special educational needs and disabilities young people have
- how good the area is at meeting young people's special educational needs and disabilities.
