

Maintenance of the animal's health and welfare in retirement.	To ensure the health and welfare of Frosty in retirement, if possible, the existing care plan for him will be maintained and followed. However in liaison with, and on advice from the Lead Veterinary Surgeon regarding his care, the care plan will be reviewed and adjusted if necessary to suit his retirement and to ensure his wellbeing. Retirement care will be reviewed at regular intervals.		
Details of the accommodation and enrichment to be provided.	These details would be the same as inspected by the Circus Veterinary Inspector when Frosty is normally in winter quarters with any adjustments or additional needs the Lead Veterinary Surgeon decides at that retirement point in order to maintain his health, welfare and wellbeing.		
Social needs of the group or individual animal.	The reindeer which travel and live together on Peter Jolly's Circus are kept separately from the hoof stock as it is important that they are not allowed to graze continuously but have their own paddock arrangements. Their dietary needs are also different from the hoof stock and all of these considerations would continue at the home winter quarters where the reindeer would be retired.

Application for a licence under the Welfare of Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (England) Regulations 2012

Thank you for your application for a licence under the Welfare of Wild Animals in Travelling Circuses (England) Regulations 2012 received in this office on {Insert date received}

I am pleased to inform you that the documents submitted with your application have been assessed and we are able to proceed to the next step in your application. We have appointed  as the inspector to undertake the necessary first inspection of your premises. The purpose of this inspection is to allow you to demonstrate that the required licensing conditions would be complied with. You will be charged for the cost of this inspection once it has taken place. A successful inspection must be completed and paid for before we can issue you with a licence.

The inspector will make contact with you shortly, either by phone or email, to arrange a mutually convenient time to undertake the inspection.

The findings of the inspection will then be considered by a panel of officials on behalf of the Secretary of State. Based on the findings, the panel will recommend whether you will be issued with a licence or whether further work on your application first needs to be undertaken. Please be aware that any further work may require a further inspection, for which you will be charged, before a licence can be issued.

Reindeer 'Frosty'

With regard to your request to identify the reindeer 'Frosty' (Reindeer UK FN 0837/000001) by means of a tamper-proof unique ear tag rather than microchip, on the basis that 'Frosty' is already ear-tagged (as required by the relevant movement of Deer requirements) this permission is granted. Please keep a copy of this approval with your list of licensed

animals. You are reminded that it is your responsibility to ensure the inspector will reasonably be able to read the tag during an inspection.

On the acquisition of new wild animals, you are also reminded that the Regulations require that you must give Defra at least fourteen days written notice before acquiring a wild animal for use in your travelling circus. Your associate [REDACTED] did notify Defra verbally in December of your intention to acquire the Reindeer, but this was not supported – as advised – by a formal written notification. However, as your circus is currently not touring we are content on this occasion to accept your application for a licence, with updated stocklist, as the formal written notification and, given that we were verbally notified in December of this addition, we will allow that the formal 14 day notification period has now ended.

Unless you have a currently valid licence you must not operate a travelling circus with wild animals. This means that no wild animal can be kept as part of your circus. Under the Animal Welfare Act 2006, the maximum penalty for operating a travelling circus with wild animals without a licence is 6 months' imprisonment or a fine not exceeding £5,000 or both. If your wild animals are dangerous wild animals within the meaning of the Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976, they will need to be licensed under that Act which is administered by local authorities. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are compliant with any other laws that are relevant to the keeping of wild animals.
