Land Drainage Act 1991
The Pevensey and Cuckmere Water Level Management Board Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 3(5) and (7) of the Land Drainage Act 1991, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted by the Environment Agency under section 3(1) of the Act.

The scheme makes provision for:

- i) the abolition of the Pevensey Levels Internal Drainage District;
- ii) the abolition of the River Cuckmere Internal Drainage District; and
- i) the constitution of the Pevensey and Cuckmere Water Level Management District and Board;
- ii) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Scheme has been deposited at the offices of the Environment Agency, Coast Road, Pevensey Bay, East Sussex, BN24 6ND and at Wealden District Council, Vicarage Lane, Hailsham, East Sussex, BN27 2AX, and at the offices of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, Area 3C Nobel House, 17 Smith Square, London SW1P 3JR for public inspection during normal office working hours for a period of thirty days after the date of publication of this Notice.

Copies of the draft Order may be obtained from the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs.

Any objection to the draft Order should be made in writing and sent to the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, Area 3C, at the above address, within the period mentioned above, quoting reference number LDC 2503.
