Gloucestershire County Council WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53 (Public Bridleway HMA 3) (Parish of Maugersbury) Diversion Order 2015

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 01 October 2015

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the lengths of public footpath described below in Part 1 to the line described in Part 2 below.

Part 1 Description of Existing Path or Way

The length of public bridleway numbered HMA 3 for the Parish of Maugersbury that commences at point marked A on the Order Plan at OSGR SP 1814/2429 east of Hyde Mill then extends in a generally westerly then northerly direction for approximately 230 metres to a point marked B at OSGR SP 1796/2433 north-north-east of Hyde Mill and shown by a bold continuous black line and being an undefined width throughout.

Part 2 Description of New Path or Way

A length of bridleway that commences at the said point marked A then extends in a generally northerly then westerly direction for approximately 190 metres to a point marked C at OSGR SP 1799/2434 north-east of Hyde Mill then extends in the same direction for approximately 40 metres to the said point marked B and having a width of 5 metres between points A and C and 4 metres between points C and B.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 15 October 2015]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 26 November 2015]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 07 January 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
