Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed. 7.27.1 The MDP have adopted the agreed DAC procedures in full (Annex D), all such requests will be coordinated by the respective FDO's. No paperwork is to be submitted without the appropriate governance.

#### INTRODUCTION

1. Due to the Defence Transformation Process and the likely reduction to the total MWD population across Defence as a whole, the DAC must be prepared to receive MWD for assessment for possible retraining or disposal.

#### AIM

2. The aim of this policy is to give clear direction concerning the management of all requests for return of MWD for assessment.

#### RETURN PROCEDURE

- 3. The following procedure must be adhered to in all cases:
  - a. Requests for MWD to be returned to the DAC will only be accepted from recognised agency inspectorate V\$TAT/PMDI/DEO/FDO/QMSI/CT.

- b. Requests to return MWD (Annex A) must be completed and submitted to the CT CTS or SSgt Trg for remount and VO VTS for veterinary. A minimum of 10 days prior to the desired return date iot enable the request to be properly considered and either approved or rejected.
- c. If the request to return the MWD to the DAC is accepted, the CT or SSgt Trg should coordinate a mutually convenient return date with the relevant inspectorate for return of the MWD from the referring authority. An appointment should also be made to enable Veterinary Inspection on arrival.
- d. All MWDs returned to the DAC must be accompanied by their handler or a handler from the dispatching unit who is able to handle the dog during any assessment. The following are to be presented on arrival prior to Inspection/assessment of MWD:
  - (i) Up-to-date Pen Picture.
  - (ii) Service Dog Record (Part 1 & 2).
  - (iii) AFO Transfer of Army Animals.
- e. If the request to return the MWD to DAC is rejected, the CT will in conjunction with OC CTS reply in writing to the referring authority, stating the reasons for rejection and suggested COA(s).

#### **ASSESSMENT**

- 4. The following procedure must be adhered to in all cases:
  - a. Once a MWD has been returned to DAC, ownership must be formally transferred to the DAC/HQ ARTD unless a prior agreement to retain ownership has already been prearranged with the DAC.
  - b. A further period of assessment of the MWD(s) suitability for continued service, transfer to the training fleet, sale or euthanasia will then be undertaken by CTS/VTS and presented to the CT or SSgt Trg for endorsement within 21 days. The outcome of the assessment should be notified to the relevant inspectorate together with DAC's direction on disposal.

#### SUMMARY

 This policy offers clear guidelines to all personnel with regard to the return of MWD for assessment/retraining to DAC. All personnel are to be fully conversant with this policy.

## GUIDANCE NOTES FOR SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION TO LIVE CASTING A SERVICE DOG

- 1. The live casting of service dogs is the responsibility of the Director Army Veterinary & Remount Services (DAVRS).
- 2. To aid the application process it is imperative that as much detail as possible is produced on the suitability of both the dog (temperament, health) and that of the prospective owner.
- 3. Therefore to aid the application process and to standardise its format, the following Guide has been produced and must be followed for all applications to live east service dogs.
  - a. Action by the VSET / PMDE / MDP DIT
- Applicant's letter received and endorsed by the relevant Service Dog Inspectorate
- Training / Suitability Report completed by relevant Service Dog Inspectorate (including DAVRS 164 if training))
- Live Cast Veterinary Evaluation Report completed (by a Military Veterinary Surgeon & including DAVRS 164 if Veterinary)
- All supporting Documentation & Animal History Sheet forwarded to DAVRS<sup>2</sup>.

## PEN PICTURE POLICE DOG NURBO 0077 AGE 7 YEARS 8 MONTHS DOB AUG 2007



**TRACKING:** Nurbo is a very good rural and urban tracker being positive in the harness when on track and giving good negatives. He is totally focused and not easily distracted. Nurbo will locate an article on track, stopping briefly before moving on in order to complete the track.

**PROPERTY SEARCH:** Nurbo is very good at his property search and will drive out and sweep the whole area before systematically locating the articles. He is very good at listening to his handler, turning on command. He has a very positive set on any found article where he will stand and face his handler, letting him know the exact location of the property found.

**OPEN AREA AND BUILDING SEARCH:** Nurbo is very good at open area and building search. He tends to love this aspect of his work and will drive on until person or persons are found.

**USE OF FORCE:** Nurbo is very willing to chase and detain. He has a very clean bite, terminating on the first command.

**GUN ATTACK:** Nurbo is committed to the attack and has no hesitation in engaging the sleeve.

**STAND OFF AND EMERGENCY STOP:** Nurbo is a very obedient dog, and will terminate or stand off on the first command. He will keep his position until instructed otherwise, unless the decoy attempts to escape or attack.

**CROWD AWARENESS:** No problems with crowd awareness and calms down quickly in order to patrol back through a passive crowd.

**OBEDIENCE:** Nurbo has no problems with obedience, which is a very strong aspect of his work. He is always willing to please.

AGILITY: Due to Nurbo's ill health he is less agile.

PLAY: Nurbo is a joy as he is a very affectionate and person-loving dog.

**MUZZLING:** Nurbo will accept the muzzle without issue, from the handler, kennel staff and other Police Dog handlers.

**HEALTH:** Nurbo has attended the vets for the last four to five years, due to ill health, ranging from skin conditions to intestinal conditions, to lameness. And laterally, spondylitis and early signs of CDRM.

FOOD: 350 grams x twice daily.


**GENERAL OVERVIEW:** Nurbo has been an excellent Police Dog during the 5 and a half years of being teamed up with him. He has always achieved his licence without any great difficulty. Nurbo is a great all round dog who enjoys play and loves to please his handler.

- I respectfully request that I be granted permission to live cast my current Police Dog 0077 NURBO, who is now 7 years 8 months old. During the last vet visit in April 2015 it was advised that NURBO was no longer fit to work.
- I have discussed this application with my wife who is fully supportive of NURBO coming home. I already have a pet dog at home but have no concerns with either dog once they have been introduced correctly.
- I am currently living in a detached home with a secure fully fenced garden. In addition, I have grassed areas fields, and country walks surrounding my home.
- 4. I have handled NURBO since October 2009. He has always been very well behaved and obedient around people and other dogs. He is of a fantastic nature, being friendly with everyone he meets.
- 5. NURBO has no unprovoked bites or aggression reports against him.
- I have handled NURBO for almost 6 years, and have built a great bond with him. We have successfully licensed every year.
- 7. I have familiarised myself with MDP/DAC Live Casting of MWD Procedures. Further to this, I am also aware that if successful, public liability insurance will be required and that any future costs (veterinary –food etc) will be borne by me. NURBO is on medication for life, which I am happy to cover.

1. I forward you this Application which has been submitted by Livecast his current GPPD "NURBO" now that the dog has come to the end of its working life. This fact was stated during the last visit to the Vets when it was diagnosed with Spondylosis and Possible Early CDRM and classed as Unfit for Duty. Due to this I do not believe that DAC will wish to have the dog returned to them.

- 2. I have checked the records and there are no Bites or unprovoked aggression reports raised against this dog. I therefore have no hesitation in recommending that this application is forwarded through the chain of Command to OCC Compliance Dept and eventually to FDO (N). All other forms that are required have been completed and await the outcome of this General Application.
- 3. Forwarded for further approval and onward transmission.
