Mandatory level

Coefficient of Performance (COP)	Units at a low temperature must have a coefficient of performance (COP) of better than 1.6, as in the criteria of the Government's Enhanced Capital Allowances scheme.
	Units at a medium temperature must have a coefficient of performance (COP) of better than 2.8.
	Units at a high temperature must have a coefficient of performance (COP) of better than 3.9.
