Thank you for your email of 3 February requesting the following information:

Information on the training of Royal Logistics Corps (RLC) Movements Controllers, specifically:

- *For each training year from 2007/08 to 2014/15, how many soldiers attended the RLC Movement controller Class 2 course and of these how many passed the course?*
- *For each training year from 2007/08 to 2014/15, how many soldiers attended the RLC Movement controller Class 1 course and of these how many passed the course?*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that the information in scope of your request is held. The information you have requested can be found below. Please note that these figures are single service estimates only and are not official statistics produced by Defence Statistics.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
