8. Over the weekend, the Harare suburb of Highfield and the town of Chinoyi also experienced similar raids by police, the extent of which is not yet known.

### Response

9. A three-pronged response is required:
- **Emergency Assistance** for those affected who have no alternative means of support.
  - **Advocacy** for GoZ to stop causing the displacements, and allow the delivery of humanitarian assistance to those affected.
  - **Access to legal recourse** for those unjustly arrested and displaced.
10. DFID/FCO are key players in the response, and are collaborating closely with colleagues in the UN, donor community and humanitarian organisations.

### Emergency Assistance

11. The majority of people affected are likely to stay with friends and family or use savings/selling assets to return to rural homes. Transport is being hampered by the prevailing fuel shortage resulting in fewer buses running at higher prices. However many vulnerable households have no real coping strategies. **The humanitarian response will be based on international standards and focused on affected people, particularly the chronically ill**
