## PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information about live animal exports on 19 September 2014 and 2 October 2014, which we received on 18 December 2015. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

“Under the Freedom of Information Act I would like to request information on two shipments of live animals. The first shipment arrived at Ramsgate Port for export from the UK on 19 September 2014. The vehicle in question had the registrations BV XF 22 for the tractor and 03 WG NK for the trailer.

The other vehicle in arrived at Ramsgate Port for export from the UK on 2 October 2014. The vehicle in question had the registrations BN GV 02 for the tractor and OK 16 YN for the trailer.

Please can you provide me with copies of the following paperwork (Please do not redact registration plates from any of this paperwork so that I can see it is connected to the vehicle above):

APHA hold no information regarding vehicle BN GV 02/ OK 16 YN that arrived at Ramsgate on 2 October 2014. APHA do hold information for vehicle BN GV 01/ OK 16 YN and is supplied below.

Please could you also advise as to whether these vehicles received an inspection by Animal Health at the Port of Ramsgate and if so for how long?"

APHA inspected vehicle BV XF 22/03 WG NK at the Port of Ramsgate. The WIT32 inspection report is at Appendix 4. The length of time for a check is not recorded as APHA are not routinely required to record this information. All checks undertaken at Ramsgate Port take as long as is necessary to complete the check thoroughly, but without causing undue addition to the animal's journey time.

APHA did not inspect the vehicle BN GV 01/OK 16 YN or vehicle BZ HX 63/OF 68 RN at the port of Ramsgate so a Portal WIT32 is not attached.

Please note the following information regarding vehicle BN GV 01/OK 16 YN:

- BN GV 01/OF 68 RN loaded at the premises of origin A and collected 460 sheep. It then travelled to the premises of origin B and collected a further 127 sheep totalling 587. After loading the tractor unit was swapped to BZ HX 63 and continued the journey with trailer OF 68 RN and 587 sheep.
- BZ HX 63/OK 16 YN was loaded at the premises of origin B with 449 sheep. After loading the tractor unit was swapped to BN GV 01 and continued the journey with trailer OK 16 YN and 449 sheep.

Information has been redacted under Section 40(2) and Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Section 40(2) refers to other people's personal information. Some of the information contained within the requested document has been withheld under section 40(2) (third party personal data) of the FOIA as the information constitutes personal data relating to a third party. Section 40(2) of the FOIA provides that personal data relating to third parties is exempt information if disclosure would breach the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA).

APHA consider that disclosure of this information is likely to breach the first data protection principle in Schedule 1 of the DPA, which relates to the fair and lawful processing of personal data, in two ways. First, disclosure would not constitute 'fair' processing of the personal data, second, disclosure would not satisfy any of the conditions for data processing set out in Schedule 2 to the DPA. Therefore, we have concluded that this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the FOIA.

Section 38 refers to the exemption from the duty to provide information if it would, or would be likely to affect anyone's health or safety.

We recognise that there is a general presumption in favour of transparency and openness concerning our work, and providing the general public with the right to request access to information held by public authorities.

We also recognise that there is a public interest in disclosure of this specific information in order to increase this transparency and aid well-informed debates concerning the welfare and transportation of animals, and the individuals associated with them.

However, we feel that there is a stronger public interest in withholding the information as the full address of the premises of origin, destination and/or rest stops, transporter details and individual names would identify further information and would, or would be likely to, endanger the health and safety of staff. This poses a substantial risk to the health and safety of individuals associated with the transportation of animals that would be of significant severity and is likely to occur in some cases. We consider this to be a significant factor in favour of maintaining the exemption.

APHA has balanced the real threat to the health and safety of individuals which disclosure of the requested information would be likely to cause, against the public interest arguments in favour of disclosure. In this instance the APHA does not consider that disclosing the information requested in order to inform public debate and to

promote accountability and transparency would justify the risk to individuals' health and safety.
