'The Regulatory Framework for Social Housing from April 2012' sets out our regulatory standards, the outcomes that registered providers are expected to achieve and the specific expectations of the HCA as the regulator. In addition, 'Regulating the Standards' (published in May 2012) sets out our approach to regulation, including what registered providers can expect from the HCA as regulator. The Social Housing Regulator's (SHR) primary regulation principle is co-regulation. Underpinning this principle, the SHR's operational approach is founded on three principles:


- Assurance based regulation
