My request is simply the full names and addresses of all of the companies who submitted a PQQ and / or ITT for this tender and whether they were successful or not, I would like to receive this information in either Word or Excel please.

I am treating your email as a request for information under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000. A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

A pre-qualification questionnaire was issued for this requirement which resulted in interest from two companies:

- Ether NDE Ltd, Endeavour House, 3 Roundwood Lane, Harpenden, AL5 3BW
- Olympus KeyMed (Medical and Industrial Equipment) Ltd, KeyMed House, Stock Road, Southend on Sea, SS2 5QH

Both companies responded to the invitation to tender and Ether NDE Ltd was assessed as the successful bidder.
